



Private Event Guidelines

- Prior to use of the event space a credit card must be placed on file with the bartender as the organizer's tab. The tab will need to remain open until either (a) the party ends or (b) the minimum is reached.
- Not allowed: glitter/confetti, fire or water features, animals
- Outside alcohol is not allowed at the party and is grounds for immediate cancellation of the party
- No smoking or vaping is allowed in the taproom or on the patio. The driveway and parking lot out front and parking lot in back are available for smoking/vaping. Please do not litter.
- Staff parking lot (by our mailbox) can be used for loading and unloading of decorations and catering. Vehicles should not be left parked in that area other than loading/unloading
- Grainworks is not responsible for damage to any vehicles and vehicles may be towed from the staff/delivery lot at the owners' expense.
- Decorations may not be affixed to painted or stickered walls, only to trim pieces
- It is Grainworks policy that any tabs left open at the end of business will be closed out with a 20% gratuity
- All guests purchasing alcohol must be 21+ and must have a valid ID. Grainworks only accepts current drivers licenses (paper is only accepted if accompanied by the expired ID or a passport/military ID), passports, and military ID. All forms of identification must be in good condition with no cracks or damage and can not be expired. We do not allow for parent/guardian purchases or spousal purchases of alcohol. If a minor is consuming alcohol on our property we will ask the guest drinking and the guest that provided the alcohol to leave.
- Any damage assessed will be charged/billed to the party organizer at the current replacement/repair cost. This includes but not limited to: paint, doors, windows, flooring, tables, chairs, tablecloths, glassware
